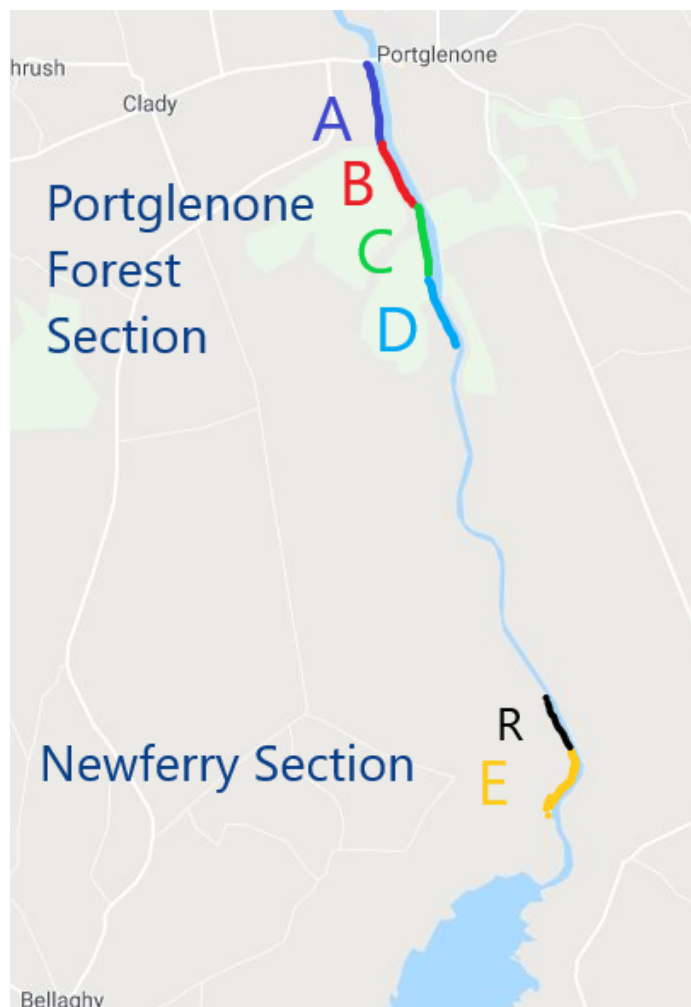
LOCATION

The locality of the championships is based around two rural communities in the Central and Mid Ulster area of Northern Ireland, an area of natural beauty & heritage close to the city of Belfast. The village HQ for the Championships is [Bellaghy, Co. Londonderry](#). Standing at the heart of the place and the people who so inspired him is the Home Place of the poet and Nobel Laureate Seamus Heaney where a stunning exhibition interprets his work. [Portglenone, Co. Antrim](#) nestles on the banks of the River Bann where you can walk from the town bridge to the area of Ancient Woodland where the River Bann flows through the forest. The current angling facility here is being upgraded paving the way for a multi-activity recreational trail alongside the River Bann and onto the community of [Newferry, Co. Antrim](#)



VENUE

The River Bann is the longest river in Northern Ireland, the Upper and Lower Bann together reaching 129km winding its way to the North West coast widening in the middle at Lough Neagh. The Lower Bann at Portglenone has a rich angling heritage home to a number of large coarse angling festivals in years gone by.



The [Lower River Bann](#) is a canalised waterway of 60km with navigational locks. Popular with water enthusiasts it has minimal commercial traffic. Roach are the predominant species with hybrids, perch and the bonus bream.

The Championships will be based around the [Portglenone Forest](#) section with average depths of 5 to 7m. Here the river is lined with mature trees interspersed with angling stands at approx. 18m, accessed by a compact gravel road. A further section will be available downstream at [Newferry](#) with similar characteristics fishing from the bank surrounded by open grassland.

Athletes are reminded if they take any medication they must check it against the WADA Prohibited Substance & Methods list.

Particular attention must be paid to the use of anti- hypertensive agents, especially diuretics, which are popular in singular preparation and/or in a combination with other normally permitted drugs.
Diuretics are always forbidden.

WORLD ANTI DOPING AGENCY

For these reasons, it is necessary for every athlete or National Federation to check the list for prohibited substances and process a TUE as necessary. The Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) must be granted before taking a prohibited medication.

An application for a TUE must be requested 30 days before taking part in the championships. The application forms must be filled in carefully with your physician/doctor who must authorise the application. A physician's certificate or prescription on its own does not mean that the athlete has permission to use the prohibited substance or method.

The application should be completed either in English or French directly to the office of the CIPS President.

Money

The currency of Northern Ireland is £ Sterling. Main credit cards are in general use. € Euro is the currency in the Republic of Ireland, although most large stores in Northern Ireland will accept Euro notes, they will not accept coins. It is recommended that you enquire about exchange rates and charges.

Banks are generally open Mon to Fri 9.30am to 4.30pm. ATM machines are widely available.

Telephone

The international dialling code for Northern Ireland is + 44, for the Republic of Ireland it is + 353.

To dial a local number when in Northern Ireland dial + 44 28 and then the 8 digit number.

Mobile coverage can be limited in rural areas. There are no roaming charges but please check with your provider.

WIFI is widely available.

Driving

Drive on the Left and overtake on the Right is the rule of the Road on the island of Ireland. In Northern Ireland distance is advertised in miles and speed recorded in miles per hour (mph). Speed limits are 30mph in towns unless shown otherwise, 60mph on single carriageway roads and 70mph on dual carriageways and motorways.

Seat belts are mandatory for drivers and all passengers. If travelling through the Republic of Ireland some motorways are subject to tolls.
