Competition Venue

The Sorraia River is born in the parish of Couço and results in the junction of the Sor and the Raia Streams. Is the Portuguese Tejo's affluent with the biggest hydrographic basin, with approximately 7730 km², receiving various streams along its course, the main ones being the Erra, Divor and Juliano rivers.

This river has a vital role for the region, since the time the Romans and the Moors settled here, using the river for agriculture and communications purposes, to export products cultivated in the fertile lands of the Sorraia Valley, where they developed intricate irrigation systems that have been in use until our days.

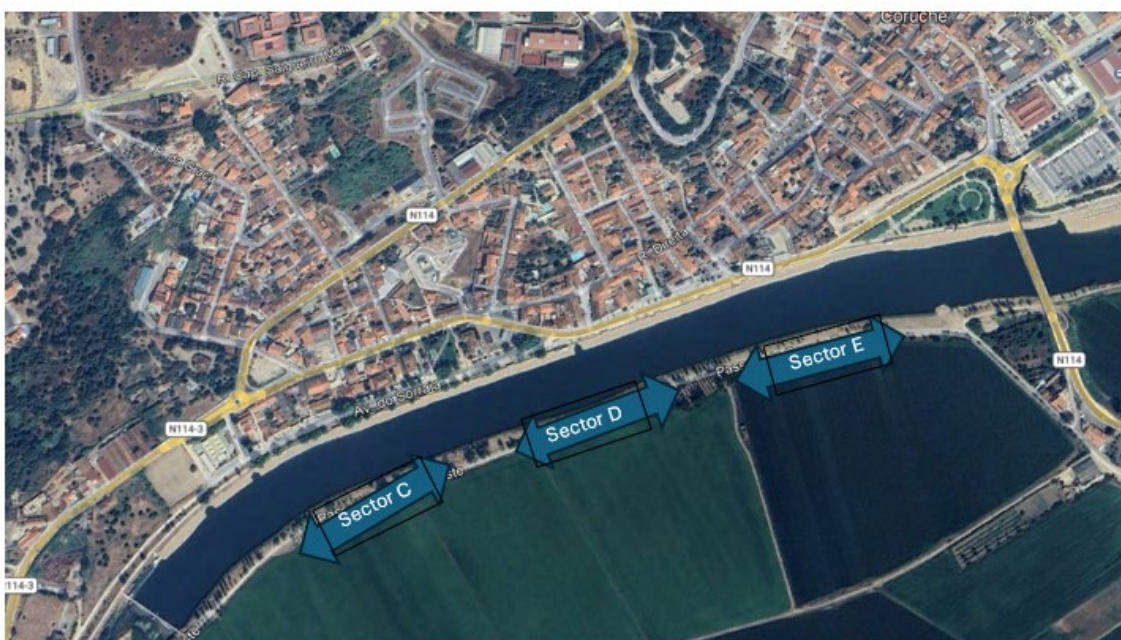
Abound in the Sorraia River various species, namely barbel, bream, carp, bleak, mullet and carassius, having developed the artisanal fishing. This species richness has turned the Sorraia river into a privileged place for the practice of sportive fishing, being considered one of the best spots for national and international competitions.



Characteristics of the Sorraia River

- Width: ± 60 to 80 meters
- Depth: 1,5 to 3,5 meters
- The water is not very clear and has a slow stream
- Sandy ground and margins, with some vegetation

Sector Locations:



Baits and Groundbaits Limit:

Baits: 2.5 liters of baits, of which a maximum of 0,250 liter can be jokers. A maximum of 0.5 liters of earthworms is allowed in total. Earthworms must be presented whole (not cut).

Bloodworms are only meant for hooking and must be presented in a “FIPSeD official size” box.

After control, bloodworms meant for hooking can be used for groundbaiting

Groundbaits: 20 liters of groundbait. Prepared (wet and sifted) groundbait must be presented at the checks in graduated buckets. This amount includes earth, gravel, corn maize, wheat, hempseed, etc., and other additives that are non-toxic for fauna and water.

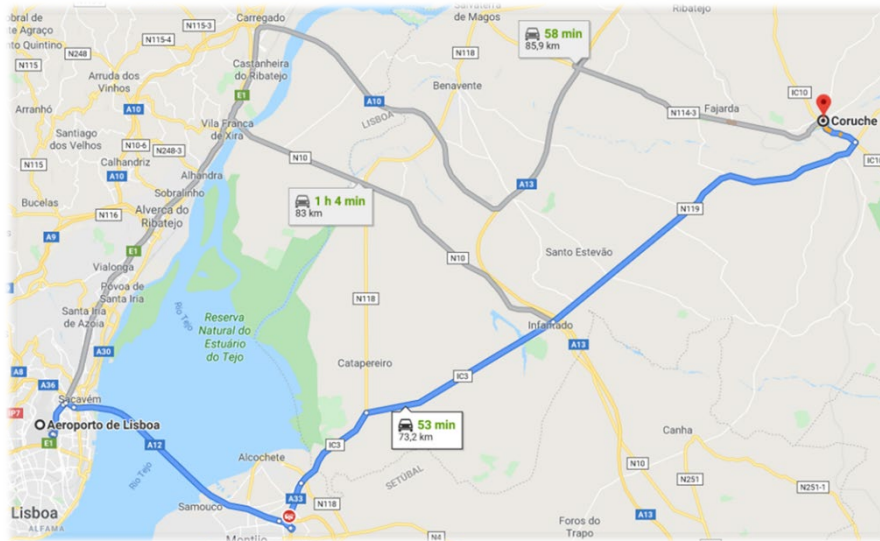

How to get to Coruche

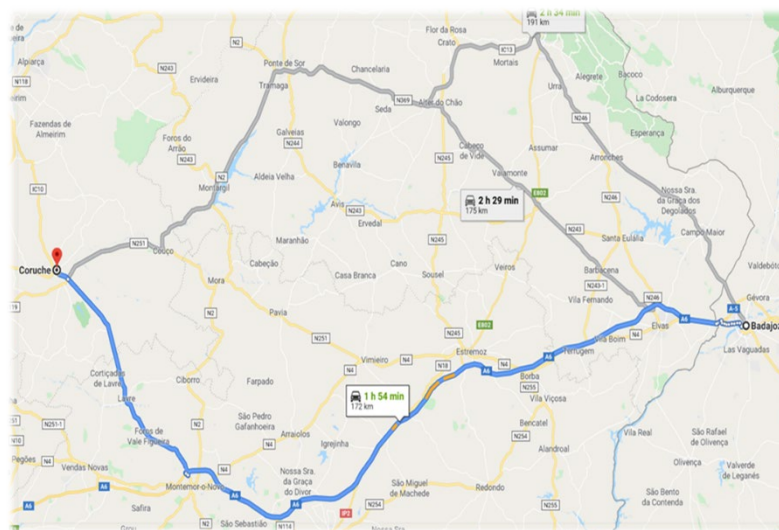
Arrival by plane – International Airport of Lisbon

- Leave the International Airport of Lisbon.
- Follow the A12 in direction to the Vasco da Gama Bridge (Ponte Vasco da Gama);
- Exit to IC3 in direction to Porto Alto/Alcochete, until the intersection to Coruche;
- Follow the N119 to Coruche.



Arrival by road:

- Enter Portugal at the Caia border (Badajoz – Spain/Elvas - Portugal);
- Follow A6 in direction to Montemor-o-Novo;
- Go to A10 in direction to Coruche.

ANTI-DOPING INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE AUT

The athletes participating in the Championship, with the registration, implicitly accept all WADA anti-doping rules. Athlete whose illness or condition requires treatment with a prohibited substance or method must apply to CIPS for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) following the CIPS strict TUE application process.

He/she shall then use the application form, which can be downloaded from the ITA website: <https://ita.sport/resource/international-testing-agency-therapeutic-use-exemption-tue-application-form/>

The TUE request has to be sent to the following address: tue@ita.sport

Athletes must therefore consult the Prohibited List https://www.wada-ama.org/sites/default/files/2025-09/2026list_en_final_clean_september_2025.pdf

If the TUE is granted, the athlete will then be permitted to use the medication during the period of validity of the TUE without committing an Anti-Doping Rules Violation (ADRV).

Regardless of whether a TUE has been granted or not, athletes should always declare on the doping control forms filled out during sample collection any medications and supplements taken within the seven days prior to sample collection, and any blood transfusions in the three months prior for blood samples.

If a TUE has already been granted by a NADO or by a RADO, the Athlete in question does not have to apply for any additional CIPS TUE, as CIPS recognizes all TUE granted by NADOs and RADOs
